# WINNERS OF FURNITURE DESIGN AWARD (FDA) 2013 AWE THE JURY WITH ENVIRONMENTAL-FRIENDLY DESIGNS

- Competition sees a 55% increase in international entries
- FDA celebrates 20th Anniversary with Special Showcase on past winners

**Singapore, 8 March 2013** – The **20<sup>th</sup> Furniture Design Award**, organized by the Singapore Furniture Industries Council (SFIC), saw newly-minted Grand Award winner Piotr Saladra from Poland, from the Designer category clinched the prestigious title among ten FDA 2013 finalists at \*SCAPE Warehouse, the epicenter of *SingaPlural 2013 – Celebrating Design*.

The winning entries emerged from a total of 343 submissions from 31 countries vying for the honours in the Designers Category (open to designers globally aged 40 and below) and Students Category (open to full-time students in international arts and design, and educational institutions). Honourable Mentions went to Diaz Adisastomo (Student category) from Indonesia, as well as Min Chen (Designer category) from China, who have impressed the jury with their critical examinations of interweaving design into the rapidly changing environment that we live in today, aptly addressing the theme, "CO-EXIST", through their works, *Common Armchair* and *Gong Shelf System* respectively.

Other winners of FDA 2013 include Merit Award winners, Denny R. Priyatna from Indonesia, Paptpimon Onplui from Thailand, Wendy Kokasih, George Soo and Sim Miao Ling from Singapore. This year's FDA registered a 55% increase in submissions from 2012. With entries from China, Indonesia, Thailand and as far away as Poland, the competition this year boasts of an expanding global outreach of design talents.

In announcing the FDA 2013 winners, Mr. Simon Ong, Chairman of SingaPlural and Design Development, Singapore Furniture Industries Council (SFIC) said, "FDA was conceptualized to develop and nurture both local and overseas design talents. Over the past 20 years, FDA has gained recognition as an international design competition of repute. This year, we celebrate FDA's 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary with a Special Showcase from our past winners. I am proud to witness the opportunities and successes that FDA winners have achieved for themselves through the years. I

have no doubt that the winners this year will follow the same growth and development path in their design career."

The "CO-EXIST" theme this year challenged designers to rethink their roles and contemplate global issues affecting the living environment today. The result was a range of furniture designs that are not only aesthetically captivating, but also reflects designers' profound thoughts on environmental sustainability.

An independent Jury Panel comprising highly regarded local and international professionals from the furniture and design industries was tasked to judge this year's entries. They include notable local design personalities - Chairman of DesignS, Tai Lee Siang; Hans Tan from Hans Tan studio; Hunn Wai from Italian-Singapore design studio Lanzavecchia+Wai; Selwyn Low from FARM, Esther Tay from Esta; and, Yang Tah Ching from Studiorigins. International jury members include renowned Dutch designer Ineke Hans and UK's leading furniture designer, Luke Hughes.

Luke Hughes added, "As sustainable design takes precedence in today's market, I am impressed with this year's winners and finalists for their creative challenges of perceptions and norms. Their innovative furniture designs invite the audience to search for deeper appreciation of and contemplation on important global issues on sustainability."
