Singapore, November 2012 Singapore Furniture Industries Council (SFIC) is pleased to announce the official launch of Project Creation at its 31st Annual Dinner & Dance held last Friday. Attended 500 than guests, the night's celebrations was also a significant one for the Council as its newly-elected President for 2012/2014, Mr Ernie Koh, made his first opening address to the Council, staff and other guests from government agencies, trade and fellow industry leaders.

Official Launch of Project Creation

SFIC was honoured to have Minister of State for Trade and Industry Mr Teo Ser Luck grace the D&D and officiate the launch of Project Creation, a Singapore Workforce Skills Qualifications (WSQ) apprenticeship programme jointly developed by Singapore Furniture Industries Council (SFIC) and the Singapore Workforce Development Agency (WDA), and supported by both SPRING Singapore and NTUC's e2i, with the aim of building a pipeline of skilled designers and workers for the furniture industry.

To date, more than 10 WDA accredited courses have been developed and approved, with another five in the midst of development and/or pending for approval. The Institute

has rolled out more than 11 workshops, seminars, WSQ accredited courses and more than 350 participants have benefitted from them.

Said Mr Teo, "Singapore is committed to raise productivity and upgrade the skills of our workers so that we stay competitive and relevant in a fast-paced technology and knowledge-based economy. I am heartened to see that Project Creation, an initiative under the Furniture Industry Productivity Plan, will nurture and train skilled and certified designers and workers for the furniture industry. Moving forward, the Government will continue to work closely with SFIC and its members to roll out more programmes that will benefit our local furniture workforce."

Mr Koh added, "We would like to salute all companies that have contributed to the industry's good performance. Based on SPRING Singapore and SFIC's 2011 Furniture Industry Survey, the Singapore furniture industry continues to yield positive results, achieving a revenue of \$5.62 billion in 2011 – up from \$4.69 billion in 2009. SFIC, together with DesignSingapore Council, IE Singapore, JTC Corporation, SPRING Singapore, Singapore Workforce Development Agency and other relevant government agencies as well as our working partners, will continue to build on the core strengths, forge closer ties and further develop our human capabilities in order to ensure the sustained growth of the furniture industry."
