SINGAPLURAL 2013 CHARTS NEW DESIGN FRONTIER PIONEERING A MEGA INTER-DISCIPLINARY DESIGN SHOWCASE

- The 8 day-long design festival cuts across multiple design disciplines to showcase over 350 design installations from 262 participants as well as 23 seminar sessions with internationally acclaimed local and overseas design professionals
- Exhibits and activities are spread across 5 locations on the island from Singapore
 Expo to downtown Orchard Road

Singapore, **4 March 2013** – Singapore is all set to make its mark on the global map as a design hotspot as *SingaPlural*, the multi-faceted design event organised by the Singapore Furniture Industries Council (SFIC), returns alongside International Furniture Fair Singapore (IFFS) 2013/30th ASEAN Furniture Show, The Décor Show 2013 and The Hospitality Show 2013. SFIC partners Singapore's other seven design-centric associations of DesignS network to curate an extravaganza of inter-disciplinary design works at *SingaPlural 2013 – Celebrating Design* from 8 to 15 March, 2013.

SingaPlural 2013 will be more exciting, engaging and entertaining for all to enjoy and immerse in its creative design diversities. This uniquely inclusive design initiative is poised to become an annual international design event to put Singapore on the global design map. The eight-day celebration features 350 design installations from local and international design talents across diverse design disciplines including furniture, architecture, interior, graphic and landscape design. Design showcases and activities will take place in five different locations; from the Singapore Expo to the bustling streets of Orchard Road at *SCAPE, Dhoby Ghaut Green, outside The Cathay, and Park Mall

"We envision furniture in the 21st century to be driven by design innovations. This unique platform brings together a variety of industry players, design talents, both local and overseas, and a growing pool of partners, sponsors and well-wishers under the auspices of SingaPlural. We see this as a successful People, Private and Public collaborative programme." said Mr Ernie Koh, President of SFIC.

Added Mr. Simon Ong, Chairman of SingaPlural and Design Development, SFIC, "Furniture has gone beyond its functional purposes to become a lifestyle choice to be enjoyed and celebrated. This year, SingaPlural will bring design out of the galleries and showrooms and into the heart of





Singapore – Orchard Road. There are also many seminars and forums where design professionals can share their knowledge and experiences with design enthusiasts from all walks of life."

Beyond Galleries and Showrooms

Local designers have placed Singapore on the international design circuit by way of award-winning designs, signature design platforms and cutting-edge showcases at exhibitions worldwide. To increase awareness and engagement among public audiences, *SingaPlural 2013 – Celebrating Design* will take design out of studios and showrooms, to specially curated spaces in the Orchard Road area.

Landscape architects and urban planners will be presenting interactive showcases, *Play Spots* and *Art in the Park*, turning public spaces into pockets of inspiration in an otherwise normal commute route. 10 oversized outdoor installations of *Design Larger Than Life* will invite the public to shift objects around, pluck a leaf, and charge their phones within the installation; furniture showrooms revamped within 48 hours is the *48 Hours Challenge* at Park Mall; 'Co-Exist' the theme for *Furniture Design Award (FDA)* 2013 will present the astounding works of their 10 finalists at *SCAPE; FDA will celebrate its *20th Anniversary* with a Special Showcase of some of its success design stories. Students and design enthusiasts should make it a point to attend *Design Conversations* and *Insights into Design* where acclaimed professionals share their insights, design trials and tribulations, and tongue-in-cheek tips about the multi-disciplinary industry. Renowned overseas speakers include Chris Lefteri, Ineke Hans and Luke Hughes.

For the first time, design meets heritage through **30 LifeStories – bench**. 30 breakthrough designs of benches using original seating planks from the old National Stadium will bring visitors down the path of nostalgia. 30 Singapore designers work in collaboration with 5 Singapore furniture manufacturers to invite the public to partake in shared memories of the national icon. These extraordinary benches will be on public display at Dhoby Ghaut Green, outside Park Mall, *SCAPE, outside The Cathay, and the URA Centre.
