SFIC DRIVES THE FUTURE OF URBAN LIVING WITH INNOVATIVE DESIGNS AT URBAN LIVING SHOWCASE 2024

Singapore, 16 August 2024 – The Singapore Furniture Industries Council (SFIC) is set to feature cutting-edge designs aimed at enhancing urban lifestyles during the Urban Living Showcase 2024. The exhibition, supported by Enterprise Singapore (EnterpriseSG), launched at the Asian Civilisations Museum, will highlight the importance of designing and building furniture that accommodates the increasing density of urban living environments.

Mr. Joshua Koh, SFIC's Vice President and Chair of the Design Committee, expressed, "With the majority of the world's population now residing in cities, it's important to design and furnish urban spaces to meet not just practical needs but also to enhance our quality of life. The Urban Living Showcase 2024 exemplifies SFIC's vision for the local furniture industry 'to be the nexus of tomorrow's work-life integration for sustainable urban living."

About the Showcase

The Urban Living Showcase 2024 will be open to public visitors at the Asian Civilisations Museum (ACM) from 16 August to 24 September. Following this, a dedicated 80 sqm Design Innovation Programme (DIP) showcase will be presented at FIND – Design Fair Asia (FIND) from 26-28 September at Marina Bay Sands.



The projects on display highlight collaborations between local brands and manufacturers with renowned designers who have a strong global portfolio of work. The showcase includes contributions from award-winning local designers such as Gabriel Tan, and Wendy Chua, alongside international design talents like Team 2 (France), Gustavo Maggio (Italy-Argentina), Norm Architects (Denmark), Hallgeir Homstvedt (Norway), Snøhetta (Norway), Claesson Koivisto Rune (Sweden), Pauline Deltour (France), Egidio Panzera (Italy), Jin Kuramoto (Japan) and Staffan Holm (Sweden).

Design Innovation Programme (DIP)

Supported by Enterprise Singapore (EnterpriseSG), the Design Innovation Programme (DIP) aims to foster partnerships between furniture brands/manufacturers and designers. The goal is to design, produce, and launch commercially viable urban living products and solutions that enhance the design capabilities of Singapore-based furniture manufacturers and brands through collaborations with both local and international designers.

Ms. Sarah Ler, Director for Retail & Design at EnterpriseSG, emphasised, "The importance of crafting creative, user-centric designs has grown significantly for brand owners aiming to distinguish themselves in an increasingly competitive international furniture market. The DIP provides a platform for our retailers to collaborate with both local and international design innovators, and draw from global design philosophies and techniques. Through the Urban Living Showcase, which will feature the results of these collaborations, we hope that consumers will gain new insight into the vibrance of our local furniture sector, and experience



innovative and functional design that is tailored to the needs of increased density of urban living spaces."

Featured Projects

• Turn x Gabriel Tan

Turn is a brand of door levers by Verotec Pte Ltd based on a patented soft-rebound mechanism. With creative direction from Gabriel Tan Studio, *Turn* collaborated with eight internationally renowned architects and designers from Denmark, France, Italy, Japan, Norway, Singapore, and Sweden.

Ivena International x Team 2

Ivena International Pte Ltd partnered with Team 2, consisting of French-based designers Valerie and Lionel, to develop *Eco-Urban Elements*. This project is dedicated to providing sustainable and functional furniture solutions tailored for contemporary modern living.

• Star Furniture x Jarrod Lim


What's Next?
